PETITION.

To the Honorable the Judges of said Court--

The petition of Laura V. Mohler, Rutherford B. H. Mohler trustees, as hereinbefore mentioned, Daniel E. Tucker and Sarah P. Tucker, his wife, respectfully shows--

1. That the said Daniel E. Tucker and Sarah P. Tucker, his wife, executed a deed of trust dated August 15th 1910, appointing said Laura V. Mohler and Rutherford B. H. Mohler, trustees, which deed has been duly recorded among the land records for Frederick County, and that subsequently to wit, on August 16th 1910, said Daniel E. Tucker and wife executed another deed of trust wherein Edward of Tucker was named as trustee.

2. that in order to bring about a compromise, it has been agreed that the said Laura V. Mohler be appointed as co-trustee by the Circuit Court aforesaid, together with said Edward F. Tucker, under the last above mentioned deed of Trust, and that the deed of trust aforesaid dated August 15th 1910, be withdrawn from said land records, under the order of Your Honorable Court, and that Jesse F. B. Heagey be paid a counsel fee of \$50 by said trustees, out of the trust funds, for his services rendered.

Wherefore your petitioners pray your Honors to pass an order authorizing the withdrawal from said land records of said deed of trust dated August 15th 1910, and the appointment of said trustees as aforesaid, and the payment of said Counsel fee. and for such other and further relief as their case may require.
