Mr. Luther C. Ahalt, one of the plaintiffs having been produced on his own behalf and duly sworn deposes and says--

1. Mr. Ahalt, did you know Sarah E. Woodcock?

A. yes sir.

2. Is she living or dead?

A. She is dead.

3. About when did she die?

A. About eight months ago I supposed she died.

4. Look at Exhibit A and state what it is?

A. This is a note that she gave to me for money I gave to her.

5. When and where was the money first given to Mrs. Woodcock?

A. In the presence of her daughter-in-law Mes. Rosa Woodcock, about eighteen months ago, and this note has been renewed three or four times.

6. State whether or not this note had any connection with any transaction between Mrs. Woodcock and Mrs. Barker?

A. Not that I know of, I do not remember what the money was used for.

Cross examination by Mr. Newman--

1. If I understand correctly Mr. Ahalt, you lent the money represented by this note to Mrs. Woodcock?

A. Yes sir, it was at the time I lent the money One Hundred and Twenty-five dollars, but she reduced it down to One hundred and sixteen dollars at the present time.

2. Mr. Ahalt did you give Mrs. Woodcock the One Hundred and Twenty-five dollars in cash?

A. I do not remember whether all of it was in cash or partly by check, but I handed it to her in the presence of her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Rosa Woodcock.

3. Where were you and Mrs. Rosa Woodcock when you lent her this money?

A. In her dining room where she had a bed and where she was lying on her bed.

4. To the general Interrogatory.

A. No sir.

(Signature of the Witness waived.)

No other witnesses being named and produced before me, I then at the request of the solicitors of the respective parties close the deposition taken in said cause (the signature of the witnesses waived) and I now return said deposition under my hand and seal on this 15th day of September, in the year 1914, in the City of Frederick, in the State of Maryland.
