

(3) That your orators may have such other and further relief as their case may require.

MAY it please Your Honors to grant unto your orators the writ of subpoena directed to the said Raymond Toms and Pearl Toms, infants as aforesaid, residing in said Frederick County and State of Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court at some certain day to be named therein, and answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.

At the request of Abraham Toms of Wm. the following deed was recorded February 3rd 1862.

This deed made this eleventh day of August in the year eighteen hundred and sixty one by David Wyant and Nancy Wyant, his wife, Daniel Wyant and Catherine Wyant, his wife, Michael Wyant and Mary Wyant his wife, Samuel Wyant and Peter Stetler, and Elizabeth Stetler, his wife, all of Seneca County, in the State of Ohio, Witnesseth--That in consideration of one hundred and seventy dollars, the said David Wyant and Nancy Wyant, his wife, Daniel Wyant and Catherine Wyant, his wife, Michael Wyant and Mary Wyant, his wife, Samuel Wyant and Peter Stetler and Elizabeth Stetler his wife, do grant unto Abraham Toms of Wm., of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, all the following described part of a tract of land called, "Three Millseats" lying and being in Frederick County and State of Maryland, aforesaid, which a certain Yost Wyant the father of the said David Wyant, Dan'l. Wyant, Michael Wyant, Samuel Wyant and Elizabeth Stetler died seized and possessed of and which is contained within the following metes and bounds, bearings and distances to wit--Beginning for the same at the end of eighty-six and one-half perches on a division line between Lewis Munson and William Toms, and running thence North ^{four} twenty degrees east sixty-five perches to a stone planted on the division line between Henry Buhrman and William Toms, then the same course of said division line North sixty nine degrees west forty eight perches to a stone planted at the end of sixty nine perches on the fifth line of lot No. 11 conveyed to John Rice by a certain Yost Wyant for forty-four and three fourths acres of land which is now owned by a certain Daniel Ridenour then with said fifth line South sixteen degrees West sixty eight and one half perches to the end of said line, and then with a straight line to the aforesaid place of beginning, containing seventeen acres of land more or less.
