I Daniel Gladhill, of Harmony, Frederick County, State of Maryland, being in feeble health of body but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say-- And first I commend my immortal being to Him who gave it and my body to the earth to be buried with little expense or ostentation by my executor hereinafter named. And as to my worldly estate and all the Property, real, personal or mixed of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease I devise and bequeath and dispose thereof in the manner and form following, to wit--My will is that all my just debts and funeral charges shall by my executor hereinafter named be paid out of my estate as soon after my decease as shall by him be found convenient I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, Magdelene the home place on which I now reside with all the household goods during her Natural life or so long as she remains widow of mine with the privilege of having two cows and all the hogs that I own at my decease out of my estate, also all monies standing out at the time of my decease to be for the use of my wife during her natural life or during or during her widowhood. Also all the remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed to be sold either public or private for the best price that can be obtained and to the best advantage by my said executor hereinafter to be named. First a house and two lots situated in Harmony Frederick County, and State of Maryland--Second, the Baker tract improved with house and barn, containing twenty-three and one half acres, and situated in the County and State aforesaid, third the Lamar & Sifford tract, containing seventeen acres of land part of it cultivated and situated in the county and State aforesaid. Fourth the second tract containing twelve and three-quarters acres of land, situated in the County and State aforesaid. Fifth, the Shaw tract containing forty-five acres of land situated in the County and State aforesaid. All the above lands to be sold at public sale unless my executor to be named hereafter should elect otherwise and thinks he can make a better sale private he is permitted to do so, And all the monies arising from the sale of the property, real, personal and mixed to be equally divided amongst my lawful heirs, and children of my deceased daughter Sarah E. Harp, to constitute to constitute one lawful heir and after death or marriage of my wife the home place to be sold with all the personal property remaining unsold at my decease and to be equally divided as above among my lawful heirs share and share alike, And lastly I do appoint and commission my trusty friend George Dinterman executor of this my last will and testament with full power and authority to grant, alien, bargain, sell and convey all the aforesaid properties as well as I could have done when I living, revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.
