This Deed made this 19th day of July in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six by James Waters and his wife Ann Waters of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth That in Consideration of Fifty Dollars, the said James Waters and his wife Ann Waters do grant unto Daniel Gladhill of the said County, all the following described part of a tract of land called Hedges Range or be it any name whatever, Situated in Frederick County aforesaid and being part of the deed from Samuel Ahalt to James Waters dated August 2nd 1861 and recorded in liber B. G. F. No.7, folio 64, one of the land records of Frederick county, Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at a planted stone standing at the South East Corher of Daniel Gladhill's orchard lot, and running thence S. 20 1/2° E. 3 4/10 ps. to a planted stone on the west side of the public road leading from Middletown to Beallsville, thence S. 82° E. 18 1/2 ps. to a planted stone against a white oak tree, thence N. 5 1/2° E. 4 76/100 ps. to a planted stone, thence N. 88° W. 20 ps. to the beginning, containing one half acre of land, more or less. In fee simple.
