

(a) That the real estate mentioned in Exhibit A., may be sold and the proceeds applied to the payment of the Claims of Your Complainants as well as the other creditors of the said James Alonzo belt who may come in and contribute to the costs and expenses of this proceeding, and the residue paid, under the direction of Your Honorable Court, to the parties entitled thereto,

(b) That Your Complainants may have such other and further relief as to the nature and equity of their case may require.

May it please Your Honors to grant unto Your Complainants the writ of subpoena, directed to the Sheriff of Frederick County, against the said Edna Belt, widow, and Roy Belt, infant, who reside near Urbana in Frederick County M/ryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear either in person or by solicitor, in this Court, on or before a certain day to be named therein to show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.

May it please Your Honors to grant unto Your Complainants an order of Publication, giving notice to the said Calvin Belt and Fannie Belt, his wife, both of the City of Pittsburg, in the State of Pennsylvania, who are non residents of this State, of the object and substance of this bill, warning them to appear in this Court, in person or by solicitor, or on before a certain day to be named therein, to show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.

This deed made this 23rd day of February in the year 1903, A. D. by Frank Belt of Atlantic City, in the State of New Jersey, Calvin Belt and Fannie Belt, his wife, Lolla C. Brown and Eugene Brown, her husband, Laura Meredith and Robert Meredith, her husband, all of the City of Pittsburg, in the State of Pennsylvania, Lizzie Bordley, Clara E. Chester and Charles F. Chester, her husband, Martin A. Pratt and Alonzo Pratt, her husband, all of the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, and Rebecca Holland of Frederick County, said State. Whereas John Q. Belt departed this life in the year 1902 A. D. survived by his widow Fannie Belt, and the said Frank Belt, Calvin Belt, Lolla Brown, Laura Meredith, Lizzie Boardley, Clara Chester, Martha Pratt, Rebecca Hilland and Alonzo Belt of said Frederick County and aforesaid State his children and heirs at law and entitled to the rest and residue of the estate of the said John Q. Belt upon satisfaction of the said Fannie Belt's dower rights and payment of all lawful debts and judgments and whereas the said Alonzo J. Belt has paid and satisfied said debt and judgments aggregating an amount to the value of said estate equal which assigned debts and judgments remain in his hands unsatisfied and to the settlement and satisfaction thereof these these presents are executed.

Now therefore this deed witnesseth that in consideration of the premises and of the sum of One Dollar, we the aforesaid Frank Belt, Calvin Belt and Fannie Belt his wife, Lolla Brown and Eugene Brown her husband, Laura Meredith and Morris Meredith her husband, Lizzie Bordley Clara Chester and Charles Chester her husband, Martin Pratt and Alonzo Pratt, her husband and Rebecca Holland, do hereby grant and convey unto the said Alonzo Belt all our right, title claim and interest in and to that tract of land, situated, lying and being in Urbana District, Frederick County, State of Maryland, lately occupied and possessed by the aforesaid John Q. Belt and being the same lot or parcel of ground which was conveyed to said John Q. Belt by deed dated the thirteenth day of August, in the year 1858 A. D. from Daniel Baker and Catherine Baker his wife in liber B. G. F. No. 2 folio 430 one of the land records of Frederick County aforesaid, reference thereto being had will more fully and at large appear by metes and bounds containing eight acres and thirty two square perches of land.
