This deed made this 23rd day of December in the year A. D. eighteen hundred and ninety by me William A. Cramer, of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Witnesseth--That in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred and Fifty Dollars and twenty-five cents, I the said William A. Cramer do grant unto J. William Burrier, of the said County and State; aforesaid, a piece of land in fee simple being part of the same land called 'The Resurvey on Mackley' Luck' conveyed to me the said William A. Cramer by Catherine A. Cramer, Executrix on the 23rd day of December 1890. beginning for the outlines to enclose said piece or parcel of land at a stone the beginning of the aforesaid deed and with the first line of said deed N. 6° E. 32 5/10 ps to a planted stone then with divisional line now made this 13th day of December 1890, S. 36 E. 29 ps., to a planted stone N. 6° 31 9/10 ps. to a stone planted it being 20 feet South of the 2nd line of the aforesaid deed from Catherine A. Cramer executrix to William A. Cramer, then parallel with said line S. 86 E. 61 48/100 ps. then N. 86° W. 112 1/2 ps. to the beginning containing 35 3/4 acres more or less.

Cramer of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and sixth five dollars paid in hand, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I William A. Stoner do grant unto J. William Burrier of the County and State aforesaid all the following piece or parcel of land lying and being in Mount Pleasant district Frederick County, Maryland called Resurvey on "Mackleys Luck" and included within the following metes and bounds, beginning for the same at a stone planted at the end of the first line of a tract of land conveyed by the said William A. Cramer by deed dated December 23rd 1890 A. D. and running with said line allowing for corrections to conform with a survey made on the 13th day of November 1890 containing the said line N. 6° E. 32 42/100 ps. to a stone planted a line of the heirs of Catherine Ogle thence
