Wittler, all of which will more fully and at large appear by reference to the contract heretofore executed, filed herewith and marked Exhibit B., and which it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint."

And that leave be granted to refile said Bill of Complaint as amended and that said amended Bill of Complaint be taken as the complaint in this cause. And as in duty bound, etc.
