COURT'S ORDER RELIEVING CHARLES O'DONNELL LEE AS TRUSTEE AND APPOINTING THE SAFE DEPOSIT & TRUST COMPANY OF BALTIMORE TRUSTEE OF COLUMBUS O'DONNELL LEE.

The petition of Charles O'Donnell Lee, trustee in the foregoing cause to be relieved of his duty as said trustee and the recommendation by Columbus O'Donnell Lee, the cestui que trust, of the name of the Safe Deposit and trust Company of Baltimore, as a suitable Corporation to be appointed trustee in this cause in the place and stead of Charles O'Donnell Lee, and all of the other proceedings in this cause having been duly read and considered by the Court;

And it is further ordered that the said CHARLES O'Donnell Lee shall assign and transfer unto The Safe Reposit and Trust Company of Baltimore, the Sum of Ten Thousand Five Hundred and Six Dollars and ten cents, (\$10,506.00) that being the entire amount of the trust funds remaining in his hands under the audit filed in this cause, and thereupon the said The SAFE Deposit and Trust Company, of Baltimore, shall execute a release unto Charles O'Donnell Lee, acquitting and discharging him from all claims or demands which might or could possibly be brought against him, the said Charles O'Donnell Lee, for and on account of said sum of money in said auditors account.
