This deed made this 9th day of November in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine (1899) by Daniel J. Staup, and Cordelia A. Staup, his wife, of Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland, Witness eth--That in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and ninety five dollars, the said Daniel W. Staup do grant and convey unto Harry F. Staup, of Frederick County Maryland, his heirs and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the District of Johnsville, Frederick County, Maryland, being a part of a tract of land called "Wolf Parish" and also being the same land which was conveyed by George W. Rogers and Maggie J. Rogers, his wife, by deed bearing date the 25th day of September in the year 1884, unto the said Daniel J. Staup and recorded in liber A. F.
