

four per cent per annum so long as any part of the said purchase money shall remain unpaid and the said sum of eight Thousand Dollars shall be held in trust and the income therefrom paid annually to my said son during his natural life, and at his death to be equally divided among the wife and children of my said son, in equal portions, share and share alike, And i hereby authorize and empower my executor hereinafter named to execute such conveyance as may be necessary to convey the title to said farm to my said son in the event of my said son being desirous to own he same upon the conditions hereinbefore mentioned.

I hereby constitute and appoint my son-in-law Howard D. Flickinger, to be sole Executor of this, my past will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other, to be my last will and testament.
