At the request of Adam W. Garber, the following deed is received for record and recorded March 1st 1899, at 1 o'clock 30 minutes P. M.

This deed made this 17th day of June in the year eighteen hundred and sixty seven by George Cline and Sarah W. Cline, his wife, of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Witnesseth--That in consideration of Three Hundred and Thirty Five Dollars and Thirty one cents, the said George Cline and Sarah E. Cline his wife do grant unto Adam W. Garber of Aforesaid county and State the following described piece or parcel of ground situated in Frederick County and State of Maryland being part of a tract of land called "Better Than None" beginning for said Parcel at a stone planted for the end of the sixth line of a deed by William Ensy and Susannah Ensy, his wife to George Cline, dated on the 19th day of February 1839, and running with the 7th line of said deed South twenty-four & a half degrees West twenty-five perches to a stone planted at the end of the 3rd line of a deed from George Kinsey & Jane Kinsey his wife to Adam Garber dated on the 17th day of March 1849, and running with said deed North seventy-six & a half degrees West sixteen perches to a stone North fifty six & three quarters degrees west nineteen & three tenths perches to a stone planted for the beginning of said deed, and at the end of 15 perches on the 9th line of aforesaid deed from William Ensy and Susannah Ensy his wife to George Cline, thence with said 9th line North six degrees West twenty-seven & a half perches to a stone at the end thereof, thence by a line of division South sixty-five & a half degrees east forty eight & fourteen perches to the place of beginning, containing six and a half acres and thirty three square perches of land in fee simple.
