In the name of God Amen. I Susan Arnold of Emmitsburg Fredreick County, Maryland. being of weak bodily health. but of sound and disposing mind memery and understanda de make publish. and declare this my last will and testament. As follows.

First. I commit My soul into the hands of God. and my body to the earth to be decently interred by my executor hereinafter named.

and after my debts and funeral expences are paid. I desire and bequeath as follows I give and bequeath to my son James Arnold all My property real personal and mixed, that is to say after my debts and funeral expences are paid. The residue of my personal property I bequeath to my son James Arnold. I also give and bequeath to my said son James. The house and lot and appurtenances.

now occupied by me situated in Emmitsburg Frederick County, Maryland. For and during his life time. And should my said son James mary, And leave any surviving children, then, at his death the said house and lot to revert to his children, and at the death of his children if any to revert to his grandchildren. And should my said son James die without leaving any children. Then the said house and lot to revert to my sons Joseph Arnold and John Thomas Arnold and my Elizabeth. intermarried with Joseph Martee jointly or to the survivor of them. to be disposed of as they think proper. And lastly I hereby appoint Edward McIntire to be executor of this my last will and testment. revoking and annulling all former wills By Me heretofore made. and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.
