The Petitioners in the above entitled cause respectfully represents unto your Honors!:-

1. That on the 25th day of August 1914, they filed a Bill of Complaint in this Court against a certain The Leats Female Orphan Asylum of Frederick County, a body corporate et al, for the sale of certain real estate of which Ellen V. Broockey dec'd, died seized and possessed and which upon her death intestate, became vested in the said Charles Francis Broockey et al, the children and heirs at law of the said Ellen V. Broockey,

2. That your Petitioners are advised that since the filing of said Bill a certain Henry Hanson Maulsby has been appointed as Trustee of Joseph F. Eisenhauer, in the place and stead of John Eisenhauer dec'd, in No. 6369. Equity, for the benefit of the creditors of the said Joseph F.
