Wherefore your petitioner prays that your Honors may pass an order directing the said Dr, Harry W.Dorsey the trustee aforesaid by a certain day to be named therein to give bond in a sufficient penalty for the faithful discharge of his duties as trustee as aforesaid agreeably to the act of Assembly in such case made and provided and enjoining that upon a failure to comply with such order the said Dr. Henry W.Dorsey will be removed from said trusteeship unless good and sufficient cause to the contrary be shown
