At the request of Emeline Mateny the following Deed was recorded  
July 30th, 1860

This Deed made this thirtieth day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred  
and sixty, by me Mary Ann Kinna of Frederick County State of Maryland, Witnesseth,  
that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and five dollars, I the said Mary  
Ann Kinna do grant unto Emeline Mateny, the wife of Henry Mateny of said County and  
State, all that part of a lot lying and situated in the town of Petersville, Freder-  
ick County, Maryland called the "Town Lot" and designated as lot No. 3, the part here-  
by intended to be conveyed is all that part of said lot No. 3 which lies south of a  
line running parallel with the south end of the town hall, and at the distance of  
four feet from the south end of the said Town Hall, it being the same part and par-  
cel of the said lot No. 3 which is excepted and mentioned in the deed for part of  
said lot No. 3 granted by me, the date of these presents, to the Trustees of the  
Methodist Episcopal Church as by reference thereto will be more fully understood.
