Sheffer, her husband, residing at 708 E. 23rd Street, Baltimore, Maryland, and also Oliver Snyder, Jr., of Woodbine, Carroll County, Maryland, commanding them and each of them to appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be therein named, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such order or decree as may be passed therein; And also that an order of publication may be granted against said Williard Lease of Toledo, in the State of Ohio, Edgar Lease and Mervin Lease of Fostoria in the State of Ohio, Allie Blue and D.S. Blue, her husband, of Flat Rock in the State of Michigan, Hattie Rease and Charles Reese, her husband, of Kansas in the State of Ohio, Harry Landis of Troy in the State of Ohio, Clarence Landis of Calexico in the State of California, Allie Landis Gibbs and W.R. Gibbs, her husband of Los Angeles in the State of California, and Annie Shoemaker of Pleasant Hill in the State of Ohio, all of whom are non-residents of the State of Maryland, as aforesaid, given them and each of them notice of the object and substance of this Bill and warning them to appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be therein named, either in person or by solicitor, and show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.

CERTIFIED COPY OF WILL OF HENRY M. SNYDER, DECEASED, EXHIBIT NO. 1 IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN.

Henry M. Snyder of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland being sick and weak in body, but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, considering the certainty of Death and the certainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world, when it shall please God, to call me hence, do therefore make and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form following that is to say;

First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried, at the discretion of my executor hereinafter named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid I devise and bequeath as follows to wit:-

Item 1st. I give and devise to my dear wife Harriet Ann, Snyder during her natural life, my house and lot of ground thereto attached, on which I now reside, being on the North side of the Street in New Market and after the death of my said wife I give and bequeath the said house and Lot of Land to my children share and share alike, I also give and bequeath to my said wife the sum of One Thousand dollars for her support and maintenance.

Item 2. I give and devise to my son Olive P. Snyder my House and lot of land adjoining my store room, in New Market to him his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple, I also give and devise to my said Son Oliver P. Snyder my said Store Room and the lot of land thereto belonging. To him his heirs and assigns forever, in fee simple, I also give and bequeath to my said son Oliver P. Snyder my half of the store goods now in my said Store, for which goods my said son must _____ to my daughters Ann, Snyder and Emma, Snyder, the sum of seven hundred and forty dollars.-

Item 3. I give and devise to my two sons Henry M. Snyder and Clarence Snyder, and to my daughter Fannie Snyder, my four acre lot of land situate near the town of New Market to them their heirs and assigns forever in fee simple,

Item 4th. I give and devise to all my children (Oliver P. Snyder excepted) my farm containing about two hundred and twenty-two acres more or less, to them their heirs and assigns forever in fee simple Share and share alike,

Item 5, I give and bequeath to my two sons Henry M. Snyder and Clarence, Snyder the sum of one hundred dollars each, Item 6, I give and bequeath to my daughter Olevia Janda Lease, wife of Thomas W. Lease, the sum of Five hundred dollars. Item 7, I give and bequeath to my two daughters Anna Snyder and Sarah Emma, Snyder, the sum of Five hundred dollars each, Item 8th, I give and bequeath all my household and kitchen furniture, to my said wife, and my four daughters share and share alike-

Item 9th. I give and bequeath to my Family and for my said Families use and benefit my horse, Cow and spring wagon, Item 10th. I devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal to be equally divided among all my children in equal portions share and share alike,
