At the request of George Hammers the following Deed was received March 2nd 1863, Stamped & Canceled.

This Deed made this second day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and Sixty three by Johnathan A. Getzendanner, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the Sum of Seven hundred and thirty dollars, the said Jonathan A. Getzendanner, dith grant unto George Hammers in fee simple, all the following described piece or parcel of ground, lying and being in Frederick town, Frederick County Maryland, being part of a tract of land, called "Taskers Chance" and designated as Lot No. 5, Beginning for said lot on the East Margin of the road leading from Frederick Town to Harpers Ferry at the end of one hundred and twenty feet on the closing line reversed of a deed from Owen Evans to Horatio Wilcoxon, dated October 8th 1838, and running thence with said line reversed, thirty feet, then in an Easterly direction one hundred and thirty feet more or less to the end of one hundred and fifteen feet on the second line of the aforesaid deed from Evans to Wilcoxon, then with the said second line reversed twenty three feet to the South East Corner of Lot No. 4, then with the Southern line of Lot No. 4 Westwardly one hundred and thirty feet to the place of beginning, and being the lot or parcel of ground, which was conveyed to the said Jonathan A. Getzendanner by Daniel Getzendanner and Mary A. Getzendanner his wife, by deed dated the 31st day of January A.D. 1859, and Recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County in Liber B.G.F.No. 3 folio 546 &c. reference therto being had will fully appear.
