The object and purpose of the Bill of Complaint, filed in this cause, is to procure a decree for the sale of certain dwelling houses and lots of ground, situated in Frederick City, Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. The bill alleges that a certain George Hammers, late of Frederick County, deceased, devised his real estate unto his three children; Alice V. Hammers, Charles F. Hammers and Mary A.C. Hammers, two of whom died after their father, but before arriving at the age of twenty-one years; that Mary A.C. Hammers survived her father and sister and departed this life in or about the month of _____ A.D. 1914, unmarried and intestate; that the Plaintiff and the defendants in this case are first cousins of the said Mary A.C. Hammers and sole heirs at law and next of kin. The Bill then alleges that the said properties are not capable of being divided among the parties entitled thereto, without loss and injury, and prays that the same may be sold under a decree of the Court and the proceeds of the sale divided among the parties thereunto entitled as their interest may appear, and for general relief.
