Luckett and Mary A. Luckett his wife, of Frederick County, in the State aforesaid John Graham and Mary C. Graham his wife, of Loudan County in the State of Virginia, Fosias C. White and Eliza White his wife, of Taylor County, in the State of Virginia, William Graham and Henrietta Graham his wife, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland and Isreal Graham of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the One part and Samuel Claggett of the aforesaid Frederick County, and State of Maryland of the other part, Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in Consideration of the sum of Twelve thousand two hundred and eighty five dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said Samuel Claggett at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold aliened and enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain seel alien and enfeoff and confirm unto the said Samuel Claggett his
