To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity. The Petition of Joseph W.L. Carty, and Charles C. Carty, Trustees, under the last will of Clarence C. Carty, late of Frederick County, deceased, respectfully shows unto your Honors.

1st. That Clarence C. Carty, late of Frederick County, deceased, died in or about the month of August in the year, 1911, leaving a last will and testament, which has been duly probated by the Orphans' Court of Frederick County, a certified copy of which is filed herewith as part hereof, marked Exhibit "A".

2nd. That among other things the said testator by his said will devised and bequeathed as follows,

"2. I give, devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate, real, personal and mixed, to my brother Joseph W.L. Carty and my son, Charles C. Carty, and the survivor of them, in trust to hold and manage the same and to collect the income therefrom, until my youngest child becomes twenty one years of age, and during said time to pay to my wife, Nannie C. Carty the sum of One Thousand Dollars annually, accounting from the time of my death, and also the sum not exceeding One hundred and seventy five dollars per annum for house rent; the remainder of said income to be added to the corpus of the trust estate and invested for the benefit thereof."

3d. "3. - Upon the arrival of my youngest child at the age of twenty -one years, I then direct that said Trustees or the survivor of them shall make distribution of said trust estate as follows: - To my wife, Nannie C. Carty, one fourth of said Estate, and the balance of said estate to be equally divided among all my children, share and share alike, the child or children of any deceased child, in all cases to take the share of the parent."

4th. "4. - I hereby empower the said trustees or the survivor of them to make all sales and conveyances of the whole or any part of my real and personal estate, which in their discretion may be necessary or desirable, either in the management of the estate during the minority of my youngest child, or for the purpose of making distribution at the end of that period as above set forth."

5th. That the said testator, left surviving him a widow, who is still living and ten children all of whom are yet alive, and that the youngest child, May Carty, will become twenty one years of age on the 12th day of May, in the year 1916.

6th. That some of the children of the said testator have assigned or encumbered their interests in said estate, though to the exact amount or extent, your petitioners are not fully advised.

Wherefore your Petitioners pray that your Honorable Court will assume jurisdiction of the administration of the trust created by the will of said testator in order that your Petitioners may have the
