

Q.24 Do you deny that you said to Mr. Thompson that Edith knew nothing of these improvements or some thing to that effect?

A. I deny having any conversation with him at all to my knowledge.

Q.25 Do you remember of saying to Mr. Stonebraker, that Mrs. Thompson knew nothing about these improvements?

A. No, if I did I do not remember it.

Q.26 Do you deny that you did say that?

A. I have any recollection of it.

Re-Direct Examination.

Q.1 Mrs. Thompson was living with you as one of your family and a daughter during the time this time that you have been testifying about?

A. Yes sir she was.

Q.2 There was no question of rent discussed between you?

A. No sir.

Q.3 She was living with you as your daughter and one of the family?

A. Yes sir.

Q. The general interrogatory was asked?

A. I do not know of anything.

S.K. Yaukey, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the defendant, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

Q.1 Please state your name, age and residence?

A. S.K. Yaukey, age 40 years and reside in Waynesboro, Pa.

Q.2 What is your occupation?

A. Superintendent of the Brick Manufacturing Company, Waynesboro, Pa.

Q.3 Have you any other occupation?

A. I do a great deal of architectural work, mostly overtime.

Q.4 You were the architect for the alterations of the Rowland cottage at Blue Ridge Summit?

A. I assisted Mrs. Rowland in scheming the arrangements that were made to her house.

Q.5 You were familiar with the premises before the alterations were made?

A. Yes sir I was.

Q.6 In your opinion what was the value of that house before the improvements were made? (Objection)

A. I would say from \$4000. to \$4500.

Q.7 Have you seen the building since the improvements were made to it?

A. I have.

Q.8 What would you say was the value of that building to-day? (Objection)

A. From \$6000. to \$6500.

Q.9 Have you designed any cottages around the Pen Mar region? (Objection)

A. I have.

Q.10 How many do you think?

A. About 15 to 20.

Q.11 Having designed this number of cottages you are in a position to tell the value of this property are you not? (Objection as to leading)

A. I am to a great extent.

Q.12 What would it cost to replace that tank on this property so as to have water in the house as it was before the alterations?

A. \$50. material and labor.

Q.13 Would that make it a strong water supply?

A. Yes sir.

CROSS EXAMINATION.

Q.1 You state that you designed 15 to 20 cottages around Pen Mar, and by reason of that you are in a position to judge values to some extent, is that right?
