

fieri facias or from in anywise interfering with the Receiver who may be appointed by your Honorab. le Court in his management and disposition of said property as your Honors may direct.

(3) That your Orator may have all such other and further relief to which he may be entitled and to your Honors shall seem just.

And your Orators prays that the writ of subpoena may be issued in the usual form against said Defendants, The Middletown Savings bank of Frederick County, Maryland, Harry G. Tritapoe, L. E. Summers, Charles E. Summers and Harry Summers, partners, trading & Co. Charles W. Boyer, and John D. Conard, Jr. Sheriff of Frederick County, all of Frederick County, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorablr Court on some certain day, to be therein named, and answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.

Also an order of publication may be issued against said Charles W. Boyer, whose present whereabouts is unknown, giving him notice of the object and substance of the Bill and warning him to be and appear upon some certain day, to be named therein, in person or by attorney, and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein. And your Orator will ever pray, &c.

At the request of Charles W. Boyer the following Deed is Received for record and recorded April 2, 1910 at 8.50 O'clock A.M.

This Deed, Made this First day of April in the year Nineteen Hundred and Ten by us, Albert A. Boyer and William E. Boyer, Executors of the last Will and Testament of Oliver Boyer, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, Witnesseth:--Whereas by a power of Sale contained in the last will and Testament of Oliver Boyer and by virtue of an order of the Orphans Court of Frederick County, the said Executors sold the home farm hereinafter described to Charles W. Boyer at and for the sum of Eighty four Hundred and Seventy Nine Dollars and one cent (\$8479.01) which Sale has been duly reported to and ratified by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County, as will fully appear by the records of said Court, And the said Eighty four Hundred and Seventy Nine Dollars and one cent (\$8479.01) purchase money having been fully paid by the purchaser aforesaid, Now therefore, in consideration of the premises, we, the said Albert A. Boyer and William E. Boyer, Executors, do hereby grant in fee simple unto the said Charles W. Boyer All those tract of land of which the said Oliver Boyer was seized and possessed, situated in Frederick County, State of Maryland and fully described in a deed from Hanson Boyer and wife to Oliver Boyer, dated May 16, 1885, and duly recorded in Liber W. I. P. No. 1. folio 25, one of the Land Records for Frederick County, said land being described in said deed as follows!--

FIRST, A tract of land called "The Spring Secured" Containing 128 acres, 3 roods and 24 Perches, conveyed unto Hanson Boyer and Oliver Boyer by John Sanner and wife by Deed dated April 4, 1866 and recorded in Liber J. W. L. C. No. 4, folio 256, one of the Land Records of Frederick County,  
SECOND, Part of a tract of land called "More Bad than Good," containing 5 acres, 2 roods and 30 Square Perches of land more or less, which was conveyed unto the said Oliver Boyer and Hanson Boyer by Elizabeth A. Biser by deed dated March 29, 1882, And Recorded in Liber A. F. No. 5, folio 212, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Making in the aggregate 134 acres, 2 Roods and 14 Perches, more or less, The interest of the said Hanson Boyer in and to the aforesaid tracts of land having been conveyed to Oliver Boyer by the aforesaid deed dated May 16, 1885. Together with all and
