At the request of Daniel Kolb the following Deed was recorded Oct. 17th 1874.

This Deed made this seventeenth day of October in the year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy Four by me David F. Kolb of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Witnesseth, in Consideration of Ten Thousand and Nine Hundred Dollars (\$10,900), I the said David F. Kolb do Grant unto Daniel Kolb of Washington City, D.C. the following two parcels or tracts of Land Situated in said Frederick County; the first of said parcels being described as follows to wit being part of a tract of Land Called "Addisons Choice and beginning for the outlines of said part at a Gum Tree Marked with Six Notches and running thence North  $38\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 21 perches to the Center of the County Road and with it S.  $26\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 27  $\frac{7}{10}$  ps S.  $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 41 ps. to the stump of a poplar tree S.  $80\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 164 ps. to the Monocacy river and with the Meanders thereof N.  $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 17 ps. N. 7 degree E. 8 ps. N.  $12^{\circ}$  W. 30 ps. N.  $6^{\circ}$  E.  $16\frac{1}{2}$  ps. N.  $8^{\circ}$  W. 33 ps to the center of a Branch and thence N.  $87\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 12 ps N.  $83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 32 ps. N  $78^{\circ}$  E. 14 ps N.  $28^{\circ}$  E. 16 ps. N.  $43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E.  $\frac{4}{10}$  ps then S.  $60^{\circ}$  E. 140 ps to the Beginning Containing 101 Acres and 25, ps. More or less and being the same parcel of Land Conveyed as the first of two parcels in a deed from Daniel Kolb administrator d. b. n. o. t. a. of Jacob Brengle, dec'd. to said David F. Kolb recorded in Liber C.M. No. 10 folio 133. & one of the Land Records of Frederick County and by reference to which a full description thereof may be had, The Second of said parcel of Land hereby Conveyed being described as follows to wit, Beginning for the outlines at a gum tree marked with 6 chops, it being at the end of the 3 line of the deed from Joseph Stouffer to Daniel Kolb deceased; then with said 3rd line reversed Correcting the same N.  $38\frac{1}{2}$  degrees East 60 perches then with the Center of the County road N.  $20\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 16  $\frac{8}{10}$  ps to a stone at the end of the 4th line of the deed from Daniel Kolb and wife to William Dean then with the 5th line thereof Correcting the same N.  $68\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  West, 130  $\frac{8}{10}$  ps S.  $68^{\circ}$  W. 20 ps S.  $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 30, ps S.  $48^{\circ}$  W. 10 ps to the end of the 4th line of the deed aforesaid from Joseph Stauffer to Daniel Kolb and with it Correcting the same S.  $60^{\circ}$  E. 140 ps to the Beginning, Containing 56, acres 3 roods and four
