Kolb his wife, do grant bargain and sell transfer and assign unto Ralph L. Hall, of Washington City, in the district of Columbia, all our right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, in and to all those tracts or parcels of land, lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland, which were mentioned, described and referred to, in the last will of Daniel Kolb deceased, duly admitted to probate and recorded in Liber J.P.P. 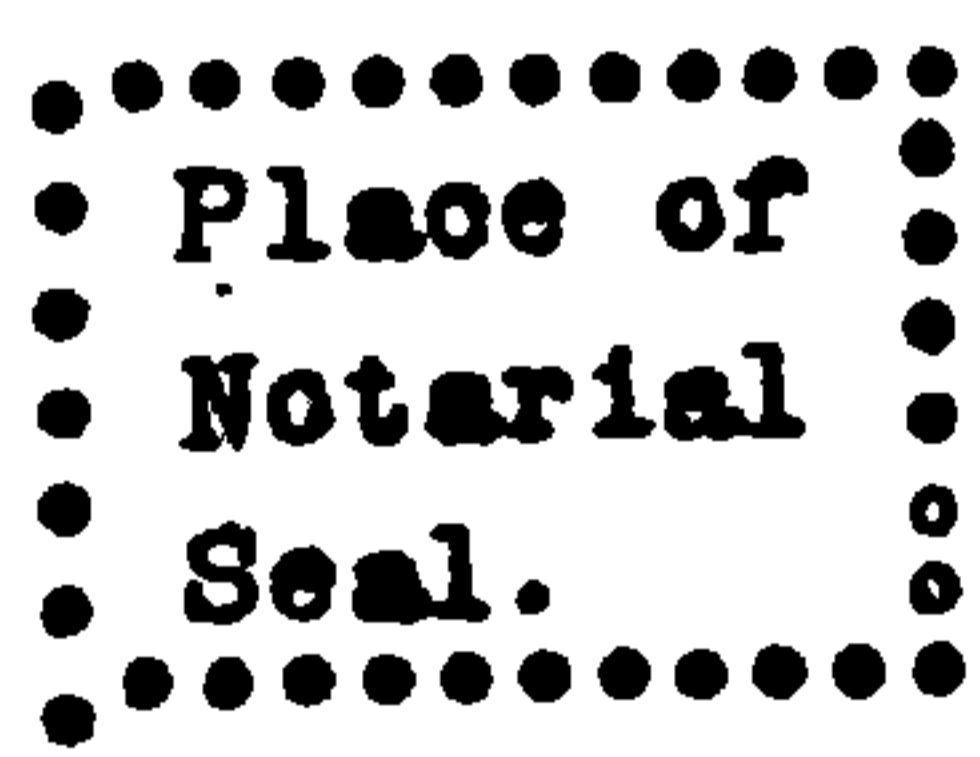
