This Inquisition taken this 27th. day of December, in the year 1915, at the court house, in Frederick City, Frederick County, and State of Maryland, before William C. Rederick, Esquire, the Sheriff of said Frederick County, in virtue of the annexed writ de lunatico inquirendo to him directed, issued out of the Circuit court of Frederick County aforesaid, sitting as a court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, upon the oaths and affirmations of Newton Woodward, Lawson Dubel, Charles Ridgley, Chris Smith, rev, Dronberg Eugene Spenseller, Adam railing Augustus heidler, William Neighbors Red Young Jr. William Darner good and lawful men of the bailiwick, who, being sworn and charged upon their oaths and affirmations to enquire, etc., etc.,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H, That the said Jurors aforesaid do find that the said Mary Elizabeth Turner, in the said Writ named, is of unsound mind and a lunatic, without lucid intervals, so that she is not capable of the government of herself or the management of her estate, and that she hath been in such state of mind for more than two years past, but how she became so, the Jurors aforesaid cannot say, unless by the visitation of God. And the jurors aforesaid do also find that the said Mary Elizabeth Turner is seized and possessed of a valuable estate real and personal, situated and being in said Frederick County, Frederick City, Maryland, valued at about (1800.) Eighteen Hundred Dollars, a particular description whereof is contained in the schedule of property which is as follows:

Real estate:- All of that lot or parcel of real estate situate near Tablers Toll Gate in Urbana District, in Frederick County, Maryland being a part of a tract called "The Resurvey on Daniels Small tract" containing forty one and one half acres and 18 ps of land more or less, and being the same real estate which was conveyed to the said Mary Elizabeth Turner, by her maiden name of Mary Elizabeth Tabler by John W. Tabler, Executor of J. Wm. Tabler, dec'd, by deed dated November 9th, 1888, and recorded in Liber W.I.P. No. 6, folio 550, one of the Land Records for Frederick County, Maryland; of the value of \$1600. Personal estate.
