To the Honorable,the Judges of said Court!:-

The Petition of George F.Tabler,Committee of Mary Elizabeth Turner,Lunatic,respectfully represen-
ts unto your Honers;-

1. That by a decree of your Honorable Court passed in the aforegeing cause,your Petitioner was appointed Committee of the person and estate of the said Mary Elizabeth Turner,Lunatic,and that your Petitiener has filed his duly approved bond with the Clerk of this Court and entered upon the discharge of his duties as such Committee.
2. That the said Mary Elizabeth Turner is at present in the care and custody of the Maryland State Hospital for the Insane of Maryland and that it is necessary for her Committee to pay for her support and treatment whilst at said Institution,and to pay the costs and expenses of the Inq-
uisition held in this case,but the said Mary Elizabeth Turner has no money belonging to her said estate which could be applied for the aforesaid purposes.
3. That the said Mary Elizabeth Turner is the owner of a certain tract of real estate containing about 41 acres of land more or less situate in Urbana District,of the value of about \$1600.00,whi-
ch was conveyed to her by a certain Jehn W.Tabler,by deed dated November 9th A.D.1888,and recorded in Liber W. I.P.No.6,folio 550,&c one of the Land Records for Frederick County,Maryland;-That in addition thereto,she is the owner of several horses and one cow,and certain machenery,and house-
hold furniture,all of which are of the value of about \$400,00,and the live stock aforesaid is now at the farm of a certain Jehn W.Tabler adjoining the aforesaid premises and is being cared for un-
der the direction of your Petitiener because Lewis Turner,the husband of the said Lunatic is not a proper person to care for and manage said live stock.
4. That it will be necessary in order to properly support and maintain the said Mary Elizabeth Turner,at said Hospital for your Petitiener to have a certain amount of money to meet her said ex-
penses semi-annually,and as her said real estate and personal property is at present unproductive,
your Petitioner believes and so states that it will be to the best interest and advantage of the estate of the said Mary Elizabeth Turner to have said personal property and said real estate sold,
and the proceeds arising from said sale invested in some safe and profitable investment,and the annual income arising therefrom applied to the payment of the care and custody of said Lunatic.
5. Your Petitioner further states that he has repeatedly tried to effect a compromise with the said Lewis Turner who is the husband of the said Lunatic,in order that he might accept a certain sum of money in lieu of his inchoate right of dower in said real estate,but the said Lewis Turner
