At the Request of William Ott the following Deed was recorded August 18 1848.

This Indenture made this thirtieth day of May in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty eight between Daniel Ramsburg of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and William Ott of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, whereas that the said Daniel Ramsburg for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty two Dollars and Eighty cents current money of the United States to him the said Daniel Ramsburg in hand paid by the said William Ott on or before the ensealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Daniel Ramsburg doth hereby acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof doth hereby acquit exonerate and discharge, the said William Ott his heirs and assigns forever he the said Daniel Ramsburg hath given granted bargained sold aliened released enfeofed and confirmed and doth by these presents give grant bargain sell alien release enfeof and confirm unto the said William Ott his heirs and assigns forever all the following parcel or lots of ground known and distinguished on the plat or plan of Lewistown Frederick County Maryland as numbers 85-86-87-88-89- at and for the sum of twenty two Dollars eighty cents current money and the said purchase money being paid in full by the said William Ott to the said Daniel Ramsburg as aforesaid and the said William Ott being now desirous to have a deed for the said lot or parcel of ground and premises executed & acknowledged according to law the said Daniel Ramsburg as aforesaid hath agreed to execute these presents, now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Daniel Ramsburg as aforesaid in consideration of the premises and also of one Dollar current money to him in hand paid by the said William Ott, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and himself therewith to be paid, hath granted bargained sold released aliened enfeofed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release enfeof and confirm unto the said William Ott his heirs and assigns forever, all those five lots of ground as aforesaid situate and lying and being in Lewistown in Frederick County and State of Maryland known and distinguished on the plan of said Town as lots No. 85. 86. 87, 88, and 89 they being the same which were conveyed to the said Daniel Ramsburg by a certain Benjamin C. Flowers Trustee of Jacob Runkles late of Frederick County and State of Maryland by deed bearing date the twenty fourth day of April eighteen hundred and eight and recorded in the land records of Frederick County as by reference thereto will more fully and at large appear, To have and to hold the same lot or parcel of ground and premises above described with every of the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said William
