

- 3. That a trustee may be appointed by this court as a substitute in the place and
stead of the United States Trust Company with all of the powers and authority vested
in the United States Trust Company by virtue of the said deed of trust.
- 4. That a receiver may forthwith be appointed for the defendant Milk Company of all
of its property in the District of Columbia with authority to continue the business
of the defendant Milk Company as a going concern until the further order of this Court
- 5. That the property of the defendant Milk Company may be sold under the direction
of this Honorable Court and the proceeds distributed among the bondholders and credi-
tors of the Company as their rights may be determined.
- 6. That the plaintiff may have such other and further referee as the nature of his
case may require.

Upon consideration of the Bill of Complaint in the above entitled cause and the
answer thereto of the White Cross Milk Company, Incorporated, and of the United States
Trust Company, and Tucker K. Sands, Receiver, and after hearing and being due considerati
on thereof, it is by the court this twenty seventh day of April A.D., 1916, adjudged,
ordered and decreed that William L. Browning be and he is hereby is appointed receiv-
er of the White Cross Milk Company, Incorporated, a corporation, of all and singular the
property, assets, rights and franchises of the White Cross Milk Company, Incorporated,
including all of the plants and business licenses, patterns, rights, real estate offices
office furniture and fixtures, and all of the buildings and property of every kind re-
al and personal owned, held, possessed or controlled by the said company, together with
all other property in connection therewith, and all moneys choses in action, credits,
bills receivable and accounts receivable. bonds, stocks, lease-hold interests, operation
contracts and other assets of every kind and all other property or rights of every
description held or possessed by it, to have and to hold the same as the officer of
and under the order and direction of this Court.

And the said receiver is hereby authorized and directed to take immediate possess-
ion of all and singular the property above described wherever situated or found and
authorized to continue the operation of the business of the said Company and systema-
tically to conduct the milk business and occupation of said White Cross Milk Company.

And the said White Cross Milk Company, and each and every of its officers, directors
agents and employes, are hereby required and commanded forthwith to turn over and to
deliver to such receiver or to his duly constituted representative, any and all books
