Willhide and by whom she had and left surviving her the following children namely a daughter Clara now the wife of George Ridge both of whom are adults residing in Washington County, a daughter Amanda now the wife of Clinton Kauffman both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County, a daughter Jennie now the wife of Alenzo C. Willard both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County, a daughter Emma Willhide who is adult unmarried and reside in Frederick County, a daughter Fannie who is adult unmarried and reside in Frederick County, a son Charles E. Willhide who is unmarried and the name of whose wife is Martha Ann Willhide both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County, a son Daniel Willhide who is an adult unmarried and reside in the state of Ohio and is one of the Plaintiffs in this cause, a daughter Addie Willhide, a daughter Florence Elsie Willhide and a son John H. Willhide each of whom is an infant unmarried and reside in Frederick County, and the Plaintiffs in this cause by their ~~father and next~~ friend Arnold R. Willhide as per his written authority herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1.

2. That said Henry Willhide of F. was at the time of his death seized and possessed of valuable land and real estate situated in Frederick County which upon his death descended to his above named heirs at law as tenants in Common, which real estate is described in deeds duly recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County and certified copies whereof are herewith filed as part hereof marked Exhibits Nos. 2, 3, & 4 except what is described in certified copies of deed herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 5.

3. That said real estate cannot be divided without loss and injury to the parties interested, and it will be to the advantage of all parties infant as well as adults that the same be sold and the proceeds divided among the parties in proportion to their respective rights. And Plaintiffs pray for the following relief.

1. That a decree may be passed for the sale of said real estate and a division of the proceeds of sale among the parties interested in proportion to their respective rights.

2. And for such other and further relief as they may be entitled to. And Plaintiffs pray for the following process. For the writ of subpoena directed to the said Nelson Willhide and Margaret Willhide his wife, Josiah Willhide and Julia Willhide his wife Ellen Fitz and Levi Fitz her husband John H. Willhide and Missouri Willhide his wife, Amanda Kauffman and Clinton Kauffman her husband, Jennie Willhide Willard and Alenzo C. Willhide Willard her husband, Emma Willhide, Fannie Willhide, Charles E. Willhide and Martha Ann Willhide his wife, adult defendants residing in Frederick County and Clara Ridge and George Ridge her husband adult defendants residing in Washington County Addie Willhide, Florence Elsie Willhide and John H. Willhide infant defendants residing in Frederick County, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and as in duty to.
