The Plaintiffs filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibits Nos, 2, 3, 4, & 5 and Exhibit S., which are herewith returned by the said Examiner.

Bernard Colliflower a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined Viva Voce deposes and says as follows:-

My name is Bernard Colliflower, my age, 65 years I reside at Graceham in Frederick County. I know the parties to this suit. I knew Henry Wilhide of F. late of Frederick County, He is dead. he died in the spring of 1894. He died intestate. He left a widow, Catherine Wilhide who is an adult residing in Frederick County. and the following children and grandchildren as his heirs at law:-

1. A son Nelson Wilhide whose wife's name is Margaret both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County.
2. A son Josiah E. Wilhide whose wife's name is Julia, both adults residing in Frederick County.
3. A daughter Ellen who is now the wife of Levi Fitz with of whom are adults living in Frederick County.
4. A son John H. Wilhide whose wife's name is Catharine M. both of whom are adults living in Frederick County.
5. The following children of a deceased daughter, Isabella M. Wilhide who intermarried with Arnold Wilhide. and who died before her father! Viz:-
 1. Clara Ridge now the wife of George Ridge both of whom are adults living in Washington County Md.,
 2. A daughter whose name I think is Amanda who married Clinton Kauffman both of whom I am informed live in Frederick County.
 3. A daughter Jennie who I am informed married Alonzo C. Willard, both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County.
 4. A daughter Emma Wilhide who was an adult residing in Frederick County but who died since the filing of the Bill in this cause, having been married to Daniel Renner.
 5. A daughter Fannie who is an adult now residing in Pennsylvania and who intermarried with Charles E. Eyer an adult since the filing of this Bill.
6. A son Charles E. Wilhide is married to Martha Ann, his wife, both of whom are adults residing Frederick County.
7. A son Daniel Wilhide an adult who now resides in Frederick County and who is one of the Plaintiffs.
8. A daughter Addie who was an infant residing in Frederick County and who died since the filing of this Bill.
- 9 & 10 Two minor children whose names I am not able to give at present. Emma Renner above mentioned left a minor child who lives with its grandfather Arnold Wilhide in Frederick County. I know the real estate of which the said Henry Wilhide of F. died seized and possessed. The said real estate is not capable of being divided among the parties in interest, without loss and injury because the parties are too numerous and the land is not suitable so as to be capable of such division. I think it would be to the benefit and advantage of all to have it sold and the proceeds divided among them.
