

I knew Henry Wilhide of F. late of Frederick County. He is dead. He died in the spring of 1894. He left no will. He left a widow, Catharine Wilhide, who resides in Frederick County. She is about 65 years of age in general good health. He also left the following children and grand children as his heirs at law Viz:-

1. A son, Nelson Wilhide whose wife's name is Margaret both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County.
2. A son Josiah E. Wilhide, whose wife's name is Julia, both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County.
3. A daughter Ellen, now the wife of Levi Fritz both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County.
4. A son, John H. Wilhide whose wife's name is Catharine M. both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County.
5. The following grandchildren the children of a deceased daughter Isabella M. Wilhide who intermarried with Arnold Wilhide, and who died before her father Viz:-
  1. Clara now the wife of George Ridge both of whom are adults residing in Washington County, Md.
  2. Amanda, now the wife of Clinton Kauffman both of whom are adults and residing in Frederick County.
  3. Jennie, now the wife of Alonzo C. Willard both of whom are adults residing in Frederick County.
  4. Emma, who married Daniel Renner and who died since the filing of the Bill leaving an infant child named Florence Edna Renner, who reside with its grandfather Arnold Wilhide, in Frederick County.
  5. Fannie who is the wife of Charles C. Eyer, both of whom are adults residing in Waynesboro Penna.
  6. Charles Wilhide whose wife's name is Martha Ann, both are adults residing in Frederick County.
  7. Daniel Wilhide who is an adult now residing in Frederick County.
  8. A daughter Addie who was an infant and died unmarried since without leaving children, since the filing of the Bill - this cause.
  9. Florence Elsie Wilhide who is an unmarried infant residing in Frederick County.
  10. John H. Wilhide who is an infant residing in Frederick County.
  11. Margaret Wilhide an infant residing - Frederick County.

The said Henry Wilhide of F. died seized and possessed of real estate in Frederick County, consisting of several tracts of Mountain Land partly cleared. Exhibits # 2, 3 & 4 now shown me describes the whole of said land, excepting portions thereof sold off as follows:- A portion sold to Winfield S. Lantz as shown by Exhibit No. 5 now shown me; and a portion sold to Joseph B. Brown (present witness) containing 21 acres more or less, for which no deed has yet been given; and a portion sold to Josiah Wilhide for which a deed has not yet been given, but the quantity I do not know. The land of which he died seized and possessed contained about 280 acres and is worth about \$12.00 per acre. Said real estate is not susceptible of division among the parties without loss and injury and it would be to the benefit of them all to have the land sold and the proceeds divided.

W Nelson Wilhide a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiffs being duly sworn and examined Viva Vose deposes and says as follows:-

My name is W. Nelson Wilhide my age 55 years, I reside in Frederick County. I do know the parties to this suit, I knew Henry Wilhide of F. late of Frederick Co. He was my father, He is dead. He died in 1894 and left no Will. He left a widow surviving him, named Catharine Wilhide who is about 76 years of age and reside in Frederick County. he also left as his heir at law the persons named in the testimony of Mr. Brown the proceeding Witness whose testimony I have heard, The persons mentioned by him is a full and correct statement of their names ages and residence. The said Henry Wilhide of F. died seized and possessed of real estate situated in Frederick County. I look at Exhibit Nos 2, 3 & 4 and they describe the real estate owned by him at the time of his death excepting therefrom that described in Exhibit No. 5, and and 2 lots containing about 21 acres sold to Jos. B. Brown and designated as lots Nos. 5 & 6 on the Plat marked "Exhibit S" herewith filed and the lot marked No. 0 on said plat sold to Josiah Wilhide containing 2 1/2 acres more or less, No deed have yet been executed for the lots sold to Brown and Josiah Wilhide. The land remaining yet unsold contains about 280
