The petition and report of sales of Otis Arnold, Assignee of Mortgage from Charles G. Huffman and Flora V. Huffman, his wife, to The Commercial State Bank, respectfully represents!

1. That on the 3rd day of June, 1916, in order to secure the payment of a certain promissory note of said date, to the Commercial State bank, for the sum of \$3500.00, the said Charles G.
