Second that your petitioner has agreed to accept the aforesaid trust, and desires your Honorable Court to assume jurisdiction of the said trust, as created by the aforesaid deed of trust. Wherefore your petitioner prays your Honors that your Honorable Court will assume jurisdiction of said trust, that the same may be administered under the jurisdiction and direction of your Honorable Court;-

That your Honorable Court may fix the bond to be given and entered unto your petitioner;- And for such other and further relief as the nature of this cause may require.

The foregoing petition having been read and considered by the Court it is thereupon this 15th day of February A.D. 1907, ordered adjudged and decreed by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, That the Circuit Court for Frederick County assume jurisdiction of the trust mentioned in the foregoing petition:-

And it is further ordered that the said John Francis Smith, trustee, execute his bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of Three Thousand Dollars conditioned upon the faithful discharge of his duties in the premises, said bond to be approved by the clerk of the Circuit Court, and it is further ordered that the Clerk of this Court docket a case in the usual form..

Copy Deed of Trust Exhibit No. 1.

This deed made this 14th day of February A D. 1907, by me Camden Ramsburg, of Frederick County Maryland, Witnesseth:-

That whereas I am indebted to various persons in various sums of money and I wish and desire to be relieved of the responsibility and annoyance incident to the management of my estate and property and believing that the revenues and income arising therefrom after the payment of all my just debts and expenses will be adequate for my support and maintenance! And whereas it is my purpose wish and desire to create a trust vesting the title to the whole of my estate and property in the charge of a trustee, who may administer the same under the jurisdiction of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, subject to the limitations and conditions hereinafter provided.

Now therefore in consideration of the premises and of the fact that I wish my property applied to the payment of my debts & the further consideration of the sum of five dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I the said Camden Ramsburg do hereby grant and convey unto John Francis Smith of Frederick County Maryland, all my property of every kind and description, and wherever the same may be situated, and whether consisting of real personal or mixed property, including such property that has already been reduced to possession and also the property to which I may be entitled from my father's Robert M. Ramsburgh's estate, he having died intestate, and any and all other
