TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT!-

Pursuant to the annexed order of your Honorable Court passed in the above entitled cause and at the request of the Solicitor for the Plaintiffs of a desire to take testimony in said cause in support of the allegations of the Bill of Complaint, I, D. Princeton Buckley, one of the standing examiners of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, duly appointed, qualified and sworn met at my law office in Frederick City, Maryland, on Friday, the 17th day of November, 1916, at the hour of 11 o'clock A.M., and then and there in the presence of the solicitor for the plaintiffs and the witnesses, with the assistance of Miss Mary Atkinson, stenographer and clerk proceeded to take the following depositions, that is to say!- Present, Leo Weinberg, Esq.
