The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answer, Exhibits testimony, and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered It is thereupon, this 9th day of December in the year nineteen hundred and 16 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, clear of the claim of dower of the defendant, Louise A. Carey and that Leo Weinberg, of Frederick County, be, and he is hereby appointed Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows: he shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court, a BOND to the State of Maryland, executed by him with a surety, or surties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Five Thousand Dollars, conditioned for the faithful performances of the trust reposed in him by this decree, or which may be reposed in him by any future order or decree in the premises. he shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real Estate, having first given at least three weeks previous notice, inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick County, and such other notice as he may think proper of the time, place, manner and terms of sale; which terms shall be as follows: One half of the purchase money to be paid in cash on the day of sale, or on the ratification thereof by the Court, the residue in six months the purchaser or purchasers giving his, her or their notes, with approved security and bearing interest from the day of sale, or all cash at the option of the purchaser. and as soon as may be convenient after any such sale or sales, the said Trustee shall return to this Court a full and particular account of the same, with an affidavit of the truth thereof, and of the fairness of
