And the Jurors aforesaid do also find that the said Charles C. L. Horsey is possessed of a one sixth interest in a farm of about 300 acres in Frederick County, Maryland as an heir at law of his father, Outerbridge Horsey, deceased, and to about 47 shares of the capital stock of the Horsey Estate Company at about \$41 per share and a one sixth interest in a purchase mortgage for \$3,000 in Frederick County.

And the Jurors aforesaid do also find that the nearest of kin of the said Charles C. L. Horsey are Elizabeth Lee Horsey, sister Mary H. Montgomery, sister, Anna C. Horsey, sister, Ann C. Horsey, sister, Thomas S. L. Horsey, brother and Outerbridge Horsey, brother.
