To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of D. E. Stone Jr., on behalf of himself and of all other creditors of Ephriam S. Sheeley, deceased, who may come in and contribute to the costs and expenses of these proceedings, respectfully shows unto your Honors:-

First. That Ephriam S. Sheeley, a resident of Frederick County, State of Maryland departed this life intestate on or about the fifth day of May in the year 1916.

Second, That the said Ephriam S. Sheeley died seized and possessed of the three following pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland; the first containing 22 acres, 2 roods and 10 perches of land, more or less; it being the real estate conveyed unto him by Susanna Lupp and John Lupp, her husband, of Adams County, in the State of Pennsylvania, by a deed bearing date April 17th, 1897, and recorded in Liber S. T. H. No. 280, folios 551, etc., one of the land records for Frederick County; a certified copy of which deed is herewith filed as Exhibit "A", and which together with all other exhibits herewith produced, it is prayed may be taken and considered as part of this Bill of Complaint; the second parcel of land, containing 64 acres of land, more or less, it being the real estate conveyed unto him by John A. W. Mathews, Laura J. Mathews, his wife, and Charles H. Brown, of Frederick County, State of Maryland, by a deed bearing date March 1st, 1904, and recorded in
