My name is Albert M. Patterson. I am fifty-seven years of age, reside at Emmitsburg, Frederick County, Maryland. I am the Register of Wills for Frederick County.

I know all the parties to this cause. I knew Ephriam S. Sheeley in his lifetime. He is dead. He died on or about the fifth day of May, nineteen hundred and sixteen, intestate, leaving no last will and Testament.
