The Bill of Complaint of Lucretia Kefauver and Noah E. Kefauver, her husband; Charles W. Michael and Cora M. Michael, his wife; Lizzie Wise and John J. Wise, her husband; Emma J. Doub (widow); Laura Leatherman and William H. leatherman, her husband; Isaac Grumbine and Alma Grumbine, his wife; William Grumbine and \_\_\_\_\_ Grumbine, his wife, respectfully shows unto your Honors!:-

(1) That Isaac Michael, late of Frederick County, but now deceased, was in his lifetime and at the time of his death seized and possessed of several pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being near "Quebec Schoolhouse," in Middletown District, Frederick County, Maryland, containing three acres of land, more or less, and being all and the same land which is described in two Mortgages from Daniel Reeder to the said Isaac Michael; the first bearing date the 14th day of September, 1858, and recorded in Liber B.G.F. No. 3, folio 431, the second bearing date the 22 day of April, 1851, and recorded in Liber W.B.T. No. 13, folio 340, certified copies of which said Mortgages are filed herewith, marked respectfully Exhibits "A" and "B", which, together with all other Exhibits filed herewith, it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint.

(2) That your Petitioners have been able to find no deed for said property conveying the same from the said Daniel Reeder to the said Isaac Michael, but your Complainants aver and so charge that the said Isaac Michael and his heirs had actual, hostile, visible, notorious, exclusive and continuous possession of the said property for a period of more than twenty years.

(3) Being seized and possessed of the property hereinbefore described, the said Isaac Michael departed this life intestate on or about the year 18\_\_\_\_, leaving surviving him no widow, but the following children and heirs at law, to-wit!:- Mary Ann Stillions a daughter, who intermarried with one Frank Stillions, and who has since died, leaving surviving her the said Frank Stillions, but no children; Elizabeth Harp, a daughter, who intermarried with Lawson Harp, both of whom are dead, but leaving surviving a daughter, Laura Leatherman, who intermarried with one William H. Leatherman, and who reside in Hagerstown, Frederick County, Maryland; Joshua Michael, a son, whose wife's name was \_\_\_\_\_ Michael, both of whom are dead, but who left surviving them a daughter Minnie Day, who intermarried with one Charles Day, and who live in West Lebanon, Indiana; Lavinia Grumbine, (widow) a daughter, who has since died, leaving surviving her a son, Isaac Grumbine, whose wife's name was Alma Grumbine, and who lives at Highfield, Washington County, Maryland; William Grumbine, a son, whose wife's name is \_\_\_\_\_ Grumbine, and who live in Westminister, Carroll County, Md; Daisy Grumbine Gorin, a daughter, who intermarried with one \_\_\_\_\_ Gorin, and who live at Claude Texas;
