Michael, who lives in Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland, a son, George Michael, whose wife's name is Susan Michael, and who lives at Fort Scott, Kansas; William H. Michael, a son, whose wife's name is Nannie Michael, and who live in the City of Washington, District of Columbia; Emma J. Doub (widow) who lives at Braddock Heights, Maryland Charles W. Michael, whose wife's name is Cora Michael, and who lives in Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland; Lizzie Wise, a daughter, who intermarried with one John J. Wise, who live at Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland; Theodore Michael, a son, whose wife's name is Mamie Michael, and who live in the city of Washington, District of Columbia; M. Luther Michael, a son, who is unmarried, and who lives in the City of Washington, D.C. and Lucretia Kefauver, a daughter, who intermarried with one Noah E. Kefauver, and who live in Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland.

(4) That the property herein mentioned is not susceptible of division among the parties thereunto entitled without great loss and injury, and it would be for the benefit and advantage to all the parties hereto, and especially the infant defendants, that said property be sold under the order and direction of your Honorable Court, and the proceeds therefrom distributed among the parties thereunto entitled, under the direction of your Honorable Court.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that the property mentioned in this Bill of Complaint may be sold by a Trustee, to be appointed by your Honorable Court, and the proceeds therefrom distributed unto the parties thereunto entitled, under the direction and supervision of your Honorable Court.

And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONORS to grant unto your Complainants a Writ of Sub-Poena in the usual form against the said Frank Stillions, who reside on the property near Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland, commanding him to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, either in person or by solicitor, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed herein, and for an order of Publication against the said Minnie Day and Charles Day, her husband; Daisy Grumbine Gorin and _____ Gorin, her husband; Carrie Grumbine, unmarried; George Michael and Susan Michael, his wife; William H. Michael and Nannie Michael, his wife; Theodore Michael and Mamie Michael, his wife, M. Luther Michael, unmarried and _____ Williams and _____ Williams, infants, all of whom are non-residents of the State of Maryland, giving notice of the substance and object of this Bill of Complaint, and warning them to be and appear in your Honorable Court, either in person or by solicitor, on or before a day certain to be named therein, to show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.

At the request of Isaac Michael & Others the following Mort-was recorded September 15th. 1858.

This Mortgage made this fourteenth day of September One Thousand Eight hundred and fifty eight Daniel Reeder of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, WHEREAS: Isaac Michael and John W. Michael have become and now endorsers on two notes in the Frederick Town Savings Institution One for the sum of One hundred dollars and the other for the sum three hundred dollars, and whereas the said Isaac Michael is individually bound, for the said Daniel Reeder as Superseders on two Judgments One for thirty Eight Dollars and the other for twenty dollars and the said Daniel Reeder being anxious to indemnify and keep harmless the said Isaac Michael and John W. Michael doth grant unto them the said Isaac Michael and John W. Michael all that lot or portion of land conveyed to him the Daniel Reeder by Benjamin Ramsburg and his wife, by deed bearing date on the twentieth second day of May 1848, and
