ORDER OF PUBLICATION.

The object of this Bill is to procure a Decree for the sale of certain real estate, situate lying and being in Middletown District, in Frederick County, State of Maryland, of which Isaac Michael died seized and possessed, for the purpose of dividing the proceeds derived from said sale among the parties thereunto entitled. The Bill that Isaac Michael was, during his lifetime, seized and possessed in fee of certain tracts of parcels of land, situate, lying and being near "Quebeck Schoolhouse", in Middletown District, Frederick County, Maryland, formerly owned by Daniel Reeder, containing three acres of land, more or less, and which the said Isaac Michael and his heirs acquired by adverse possession; that the said Isaac Michael, being seized and possessed as aforesaid, departed this life intestate in or about the year 18___, leaving surviving him no widow, but the following children and heirs at law, to-wit:-
Mary Ann Stillions, a daughter, who intermarried with one Frank Stillions, and who has since died, leaving surviving her the said Frank Stillions, but no children; Elizabeth Harp, a daughter, who intermarried with Lawson Harp, both of whom are dead, but leaving surviving a daughter, Laura Leatherman, who intermarried with one William H. leatherman, and who reside in Hagerstown, Frederick County, Maryland; Joshua Michael, a son, whose wife's name was _____ Michael, both of whom are dead, but who left surviving them a daughter, Minnie Day, who intermarried with one Charles Day, and who live in West Lebanon, Indiana; Lavinia Grumbine (widow) a daughter, who has since died, leaving surviving her a son, Isaac Grumbine, whose wife's name is Alma Grumbine, and who live at Highfield, Washington County, Maryland; William Grumbine a son, whose wife's name is _____ Grumbine, and who live in Westminster, Carroll County, Md; Daisy Grumbine Gorin, a daughter, who intermarried with one _____ Gorin, and who live at Claude, Texas, Carrie Grumbine, a daughter, who is unmarried, and who lives in the City of Richmond, State of Virginia, Minnie Grumbine, a daughter, who first intermarried with one _____ Koogle, who subsequently died without issue, the said Minnie Grumbine then intermarrying with one J.B. Williams, both of whom are now dead, but
