The writ in the nature of writ de lunatico inquirendo, issued in the above entitled cause and the return of the Sheriff of Frederick County, certifying in due execution and the finding of the Jury by the inquisition, having been filed in this Court, and it appearing from said return and the findings of the jury that the said Charles H. Heffner is so far deprived on his reason and understanding that he is unfit and unable to take care of his person or manage his estate.

It is thereupon this 27 day of October in the year Nineteen Hundred and Sixteen, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said inquisition and the return thereof be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed, and that Minnie G. Heffner, of Frederick County, be and she is hereby appointed committee of the person and trustee of the estate of said Charles H. Heffner, to take custody of his person and charge of his estate; and it is further ordered that before she proceeds to take charge of his estate as trustee, she will execute a bond to the State of Maryland, with good and sufficient security, to be approved by this Court or the Clerk thereof in the penalty of Three Thousand Dollars, conditioned that the said Minnie G. Heffner, as committee of the person and trustee of the estate of said Charles H. Heffner, will faithfully discharge her duties as such committee of the person and trustee of the estate of said Charles H. Heffner, and deliver up all the property of the said Charles H. Heffner whenever she may be required by the order of the Court so to do; and it is further ordered that the said Minnie G. Heffner, as committee of the person and trustee of the estate of said Charles H. Heffner, return to this Court an inventory specifically setting forth all property, real and personal, belonging to the estate of the said Charles H. Heffner and all cash in hand and in Bank; and further that the said Minnie G. Heffner, as such committee of person and trustee of the estate of said Charles H. Heffner shall render a full and particular account of all her expenses receipts and expenditures by her made for and on account of said estate once in each of every year or oftener if so required by the Court!- And it is further ordered that the costs of this proceeding together with reasonable counsel fee, be paid out of the funds of this estate.
