EXHIBIT "A" CERTIFIED COPY OF WILL OF WILLIAM J. WORMAN, DECEASED.

I William J. Worman of Frederick County Maryland, do hereby make and publish my last Will and Testament in manner following: That is to say: After the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses, I will devise and bequeath the rest and residue of my estate as follows: Item-I will devise and bequeath the whole of my estate, real personal and mixed, and wherever situate to my wife Mary E. Worman for and during the term of her natural life and after the death of my wife Mary E. Worman, I direct and will that the whole of my estate, be sold, by my Executor and the proceeds arising from the sale of my said property and estate, be divided share and share alike, between my two daughters Mary E. Worman and Ruth M. Worman; And in the event either of my said daughters should die before the final distribution of my said estate; leaving issue, the issue shall take per stirpes their mothers share or portion, of my said estate.

Item. I will and direct my said wife Mary E. Worman, in her discretion without the intervention of the Court to sell any part of my estate, and reinvest the proceeds, arising from said sales, in other property or securities.

And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Mary E. Worman, as the executrix of this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking all wills by me previously made confirming this as and for my Last Will and Testament as hereinbefore written May 19, 1906.
