(2) That the Defendants, their servants and agents, may be restrained and enjoined from interfering in any way with the Plaintiffs, in the quiet and peaceable enjoyment of the possession of the real estate and leases mentioned and described in said Bill. (3) That any and all clouds upon the title of the plaintiffs to said property by reason of the pretended interests of the defendants be removed by a decree of your Honorable Court. (4) That your Orators may have such other and further relief as their case may require.

And the plaintiff pray for the following process:

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Honors the order of publication giving notice to the said Lockwood C. Rines of the City of Washington in the District of Columbia, Mar-Va Development Company and the Interior Marble Quarry who are non residents of this State of the object and substance of this Bill, and warning them to appear in this Court, in person or by solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein to show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed.

"EXHIBIT NO. 1"

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into in the City of Frederick, State of Maryland, this 6th. day of March, A.D. 1910, by and between Lockwood C. Rines, of the City of Washington, District of Columbia, party of the first part and the Mar-Va Developments Company, a corporation, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, WHEREAS the party of the first part claims to own a certain option to purchase a certain tract of land and marble quarries in Frederick and Carroll Counties in the State of Maryland, and; WHEREAS the party of the second part asserts a like claim to said option which said claims are now involved in certain litigation pending in the courts of Frederick County, State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS it is the purpose of the parties hereto to settle their differences;

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of the sum of \$10.00 in hand paid, by each of the parties hereto to the other, at the signing of this agreement, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto contract and agree as follows:
