ORDER.

UPON CONSIDERATION of the bill of complaint and answer in the above entitled cause, and the defendant agreeing, and consenting hereto, it is by the Court this 20th day of November, 1916, ORDERED that Hugh H. O'bear and Charles McC. Mathias, Esquires, be and they are hereby, appointed receivers of this Court of all and singular the property, assets, rights and franchises of the Morris Iron & Steel Company wherever situate within the jurisdiction of this Court, including all the plants, machinery, offices, office furniture and fixtures, and all other buildings and the contents thereof, all supplies tools equipments, fabricated and unfabricated products and materials, and property of every kind, real and personal, owned, held, possessed or controlled by said company, together with all other property in connection therewith and all moneys, invoices, notes in action, credits, bills receivable, bonds, stocks leasehold interest, operating contracts, and other assets of every kind, and all other property and rights of every description held or possessed by it, to have and to hold the same as the officers of and under the order and direction of the Court.

The said receivers are hereby authorized and directed to take immediate possession of all and singular the property above described wherever situated in said State of Maryland or under the jurisdiction of the Court, and to continue the operation of the business of said company.

And the said Morris Iron & Steel Company, and each and every of its officers, directors, agents, and employes, are hereby required and commanded forthwith to turn over and deliver to such receivers, or their duly constituted representative, any and all books of account, vouchers, papers, deeds, leases, contracts, bills, notes, accounts, money, or other property in his, or their hands, or under his or their control, and they are hereby commanded and required to obey and conform to such orders as may be given them from time to time by the said receivers, or their duly constituted representative, in conducting the said business and in discharging their duty as such receivers.

Said receivers are hereby fully authorized to continue and operate the business of the said company as heretofore conducted and manage all its property, at their discretion, in such manner as will, in their judgment, produce the most satisfactory results, and to collect and receive all income therefrom and all debts due said company of every kind, and for such purposes they are hereby invested with full power at their discretion to employ and discharge and fix the compensation of all such officers, counsel, managers, agents, and employes as may be required for the purpose of discharging the duties of their trust. And the said receivers are directed to deposit the moneys coming into their hands in some bank or banks in the City of Frederick, in the State of Maryland, and to report their selection to the Court. Said receivers are hereby fully authorized and empowered to institute and prosecute all such suits as may be necessary in their judgment to the proper protection of the property and trusts hereby vested in them, and likewise defend all actions instituted against them
