

Dollars(\$64.00);the same being a special or interest bearing deposit,represented by interest account book No.148 D;and that it also has on deposit to the credit of Joshua A.Dill,in a checking non-interest bearing account,the sum of Sixty-four Dollars and Sixty-two Cents (\$64.62),as alleged in said petition.

2d. That as above stated,both of these amounts were deposited,and stand on the books of the Bank,to the credit of Joshua A.Dill;and this respondent has no independent knowledge of the ownership of said funds,other than the above mentioned entries disclosed.

3d. And further answering said petition,this respondent says that the question of the true ownership of said funds is one which should be determined in a proceeding had between said Trustee and the personal representatives,or next of kin,of the said Joshua A.Dill,and should not be determined on a petition by said Trustee against this respondent alone.
