And we being willing to take care for the interest of him the said Edward Ernest Adams, do command that you diligently inquire by the oaths of honest men of your bailiwick by whom the truth of the matter may be better known, whether the said Edward Ernest Adams be so far deprived of his understanding that he is now, and has since June 13th, 1916, not been capable of the management of his person and estate, And whether he be possessed of real estate and personal property, and of what nature and description, and of what value, and who is his next of kin, and of what age?

And the inquisition hereof, distinctly and plainly made, send to our Judges of the Circuit court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity, under your hand and seal, and the hands and seals of those by whom the said inquisition is made and taken.
