To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court!

Your Orator, Thomas S. Inglehart, complaining says:-

1. That William A. Arnsparger, late of Frederick County, deceased, was in his lifetime and at the time of his death, seized and possessed, in fee simple, of a large amount of real estate situate, lying and being in Hauvers District, Frederick County, State of Maryland, part of said real estate being a farm and wood lot containing together Fifty-eight acres and one hundred square perches of land upon which are improvements, the said farm and wood lot being comprised within the outlines of the following deeds to the said William A. Arnsparger, (a) the deed from Lewis Crawford, Trustee, dated the 3rd day of July A.D. 1879, and recorded in Liber A.F. No. 1, Folio 691, one of the said Land Records of said County; (b) the deed from Lavinia Williar dated March 19th 1883, recorded in Liber D.H.H. No. 7, folio 521, one of said Land Records (c) the deed from Samuel Dewees dated January 3rd, 1898, and recorded in Liber D.H.H. No. 1, folio 96, one of said Land Records (d) the deed from Helen D. Rowland et al. dated May 15th, 1911, and recorded in Liber H.W. B. No. 298, Land Records as aforesaid, and (e) the deed from Albert H. Birely and wife dated September 29th, 1911, and recorded in Liber H.W. B. No. 298, folio 370, also one of said Land Records, copies of which deeds are herewith filed as part hereof marked Exhibits A B. C. D and E; and which farm and wood lot are more particularly described in an entire survey thereof made by George W. Manahan, Surveyor, and filed herewith as part hereof and marked Exhibit G. W. M. No. 1, which together with all other Exhibits herein before or hereinafter produced, it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint.

2. That the said William A. Arnsparger also died seized and possessed in fee simple of a lot of ground containing Thirty Five square perches of land, more or less, with improvements thereon situated between Sanatorium Station and the Power House being part of the same land conveyed by the said Lewis Crawford, Trustee, by the the deed of which Exhibit A. is a certified copy, and which Thirty-Five square perches tract is more particularly described in a survey thereof made by said Surveyor and herewith filed as a
