Arnsbarger of Frederick County, Maryland, all the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being situate in Frederick County State of Maryland, Beginning for said tract to be hereby Conveyed at a corner of said Wm. A. Arnsbarger's land running thence with said Arnsbargers land S 17° E, 35, 6 perches S. 28° W. 4, 6 perches to corner of Luther Browns land then with said Browns, land W. 86° 18 perches N. 84½° W. 60 perches then with land of Samuel Royer's, heirs N. 38 W. 27 perches then with land of John Lee Chapman's 89, 5 perches to place of beginning Containing twenty acres of land be the same more or less being the same property which was conveyed by Wm.
